

Adding number to speed dial

- 1. Access the Phone's Menu: Navigate to the phone's menu by pressing the "Menu" button.
- 2. Navigate to Speed Dial Settings: Depending on the model of your Grandstream phone, you might find the speed dial settings under different menu options such as "Features," "Settings," or "Phonebook." Use the arrow keys or touchscreen to navigate to the appropriate menu.
